To get started, you can click on "Information For" on the menu button which can be found at the top left part of the welcome page. The page will give you an understanding of the services that we can provide according to the user's status whether you are a student, staff, alumni or employer.

Next, we have the "MyCoNECT" login where students, staffs and employers can have access to more features tailored for each category. Staffs and employers can sign up for an account and will be subject to approval from our side. For students, however, you can login using your current student ID and password. As for Alumni, this feature will be available to you soon.
